

The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 44-2017

Being a By-law to Appoint Charles Edward Melanson as Fire Chief for the Town of Fort Erie and to Repeal By-law No. 1-2017

Whereas the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997*, S.O. 1997, c. 4, (the "*Act*") subsection 5(0.1) provides that the council of a municipality may establish, maintain and operate a fire department for all or any part of the municipality; and

Whereas the Town of Fort Erie has established, maintains and operates a fire department; and

Whereas the *Act* provides if a fire department is established, the council of the municipality shall appoint a fire chief for the fire department and describes the powers and responsibilities of the fire chief; and

Whereas By-law No. 1-2017 appoints Deputy Fire Chief Keith German as Interim Fire Chief; and

Whereas it is desirable to appoint Charles Edward Melanson as Fire Chief;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- **1. That** Charles Edward Melanson is appointed Fire Chief for the Town of Fort Erie effective April 24, 2017 with the powers, duties and responsibilities of a Fire Chief as described in the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997*, S.O. 1997, c. 4.
- **2. That** Charles Edward Melanson is appointed pursuant to the provisions of the *Provincial Offences Act* as a Provincial Offences Officer and a Peace Officer for the purposes of enforcing the Fire Code and related municipal by-laws.
- **3.** That By-law No. 1-2017 is repealed.
- **4. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections, or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 24th day of April, 2017.
