CN 6218 TRAIN PRESERVATION STAGE ONE COMPLETE



Members of the public joined the Mayor and Council at the Fort Erie Railway Museum on October 11, 2018 to celebrate the completion of Stage One of the repair project for the CN 6218 steam engine. Stage one included measuring the stability of the track bed; removing the boiler jacket, fiberglass, asbestos, lead painting and heavy metals; making basic repairs; and re-painting the exterior.

Additionally a donation of \$10,000 was made by the Fort Erie Historical Railway Association to go towards a covering to be installed over the engine, this will be part of Stage Two, along with fabricating and installing a new boiler jacket. Stage Two is still dependent upon funding availability.
