

The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 31-2019

Being a By-law to Rename a Portion of Cherrywood Avenue North to Elizabeth Road

WHEREAS the Street Naming Committee at its meeting of November 6, 2018 recommended the renaming of an unopened portion of Cherrywood Avenue North to Elizabeth Road, in order to accommodate the development of the Elizabeth Road Subdivision and the Schooley Road Condominium to the south; and

WHEREAS at the December 10, 2018 Special Council Meeting, Council considered and approved the Street Naming Committee's recommendations contained in the Street Naming & Wayfinding Committee's Minutes of November 6, 2018 to rename an unopened portion of Cherrywood Avenue North, to Elizabeth Road; and

WHEREAS pursuant to the requirements of Street Naming Policy By-law No. 15-04 notice of the proposed street naming was published in The Post for two consecutive weeks on January 24th and 31st, 2019, and posted on the Town's website; and

WHEREAS no objections were received to the proposed street renaming; and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to proceed to rename an unopened portion of Cherrywood Avenue North, Elizabeth Road, in order to accommodate development of the Elizabeth Road Subdivision and the Schooley Road Condominium to the south;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That an unopened portion of Cherrywood Avenue North, from the south limit of Rebstock Road to 727.5 feet south more or less, legally described as Cherrywood Avenue North, Plan 431, Bertie; Fort Erie, being all of PIN 64183-0016 (LT), in the Town of Fort Erie, in the Regional Municipality of Niagara, is renamed "Elizabeth Road".
- **2. That** the Town Solicitor shall cause this by-law to be registered in the local land Registry Office.

That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 25th day of February, 2019.
