By-law No. 52-2020

Being a By-law to Amend the Highway Occupancy Policy By-law No. 120-2015 (Administrative Penalty)

Whereas By-law No. 120-2015 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on September 28, 2015 to adopt a Policy to regulate the use, alteration and occupancy of Highways (the "Policy") through a permit system with respect to construction on private properties necessitating the occupation of a portion of a highway (road allowance); and

Whereas the purpose of the permit system under the Policy is to:

- a) determine whether a proposed highway occupation is necessary;
- b) ensure highway occupancy is carried out in a safe manner;
- c) ensure that activities are coordinated to minimize public impact; and
- d) ensure Town infrastructure is protected from damage, and if damage occurs, is remediated to the satisfaction of the Town; and

Whereas By-law No. 111-2019 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on July 15, 2019 to establish a system for Administrative Penalties; and

Whereas the Policy does not currently provide for an Administrative Penalty for those who use a highway in a manner which restricts access, disrupts or impedes vehicular and/or pedestrian traffic, requires placement of materials and/or equipment of any kind on the highway, without obtaining a permit and otherwise not complying with any part of the Policy; and

Whereas it has become evident that highways are being used, altered and occupied without permits being obtained to ensure that the purpose of the Policy is achieved; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to implement an Administrative Penalty for non-compliance with the Policy; and

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- **1. That** By-law No. 120-2015 is amended by inserting the following subsection immediately following Subsection 7.1:
 - "7.2 Every person who contravenes any provision of this Policy is liable to pay an Administrative Penalty in the amount of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) in the manner and in accordance with By-law No. 111-2019, as amended or replaced from time to time, which establishes a system for Administrative Penalties."

2. That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 8th day of June, 2020.
