By-law No. 79-2020

## Being a By-law to Rename a Traveled Portion of Klauck Street to Klauck Street North

**WHEREAS** the Street Naming and Wayfinding Committee at its meeting of December 10, 2019 recommended the renaming of a traveled portion of Klauck Street to Klauck Street North, to assist with emergency response; and

**WHEREAS** at the February 18, 2020 Regular Council Meeting, Council considered and approved the Street Naming and Wayfinding Committee's recommendations contained in the Street Naming and Wayfinding Committee's Minutes of December 10, 2019 to rename a traveled portion of Klauck Street to Klauck Street North; and

**WHEREAS** pursuant to the requirements of Street Naming Policy By-law No. 15-04 notice of the proposed street renaming was published in The Post for two consecutive weeks on August 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020, and posted on the Town's website; and

WHEREAS no objections were received to the proposed street renaming; and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed desirable to proceed to rename a traveled portion of Klauck Street to Klauck Street North, in order to assist with emergency response;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- That a traveled portion of Klauck Street, legally described as Firstly: Lane, Plan 348, Village of Bridgeburg, abutting Lot 124, South Side of Dufferin Street and Lot 247, North Side of Jarvis Street; Secondly: Part Lot 247, North Side of Jarvis Street, Plan 348, Bertie, as in BR1866; Part Lot 124, South Side of Dufferin Street, Plan 348, Bertie, as in BR1736; Between Dufferin and Jarvis Streets (aka Klauck Street); Fort Erie, being all of PIN 64232-0175 (LT), in the Town of Fort Erie, in the Regional Municipality of Niagara, is renamed "Klauck Street North".
- 2. That the Town Law Clerk shall cause this by-law to be registered in the local land Registry Office.

**3.** That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.
