



The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 85-2020

Being a By-law to Appoint Mark Schmitt as Deputy Fire Chief for the Town of Fort Erie and to Repeal By-law No. 80-2017

Whereas the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997*, S.O. 1997, c. 4, (the “Act”) subsection 5(0.1) provides that the council of a municipality may establish, maintain and operate a fire department for all or any part of the municipality; and

Whereas the Town of Fort Erie has established, maintains and operates a fire department; and

Whereas the *Act* further provides if a fire department is established, the council of the municipality shall appoint a fire chief for the fire department and describes the powers and responsibilities of the fire chief; and

Whereas the *Act* further provides that a fire chief may delegate his or her powers or duties to any firefighter or class of firefighters, subject to such limitations, restrictions or conditions as may be prescribed or set out in the delegation; and

Whereas By-law No. 80-2017 appointed Jeremy Inglis as Deputy Fire Chief; and

Whereas Jeremy Inglis has resigned and it is desirable to appoint Mark Schmitt as Deputy Fire Chief;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** Mark Schmitt is appointed Deputy Fire Chief for the Town of Fort Erie effective September 8, 2020.
2. **That** Mark Schmitt, during any absence of the Fire Chief, shall be the Acting Fire Chief with the same powers, duties and responsibilities of a Fire Chief as described in the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997*, S.O. 1997, c. 4 and as prescribed by the Council from time to time. Such powers shall include, but are not limited to, the power to delegate as prescribed by the Act.
3. **That** Mark Schmitt, while acting in his capacity as Acting Fire Chief, shall be the person ultimately responsible to the Council for the delivery of fire protection services.
4. **That** Mark Schmitt is appointed a Provincial Offences Officer pursuant to the provisions of the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33 and is appointed a Peace Officer for the purposes of enforcing the Fire Code and related municipal by-laws.
5. **That** By-law No. 80-2017 is repealed.

6. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections, or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 24th day of August, 2020.
