By-law No. 99-2020

Being a By-law to Appoint Ashlea Carter as Acting Deputy Clerk in the Absence of the Clerk and Repeal By-law No. 68-2017

Whereas Section 228(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended provides interalia that a municipality shall appoint a clerk; and

Whereas Section 228(2) of said *Act* provides that a municipality may appoint deputy clerks who have all the powers and duties of the clerk under this and any other *Act*; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary to appoint a person as Acting Deputy Clerk in the absence of the Clerk from time to time; and

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** Ashlea Carter is appointed as the Acting Deputy Clerk for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie to act in the absence of the Clerk from time to time.
2. **That** By-law No. 68-2017 is repealed.
3. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 19th day of October, 2020.
