By-law No. 117-2021

## Being a By-law to Appoint Rachel Munro as Temporary Acting Deputy Clerk in the Absence of the Clerk

**Whereas** Section 228(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended provides interalia that a municipality shall appoint a clerk; and

**Whereas** Section 228(2) of said *Act* provides that a municipality may appoint deputy clerks who have all the powers and duties of the clerk under this and any other *Act*, and

**Whereas** it is deemed necessary to appoint a temporary person as Acting Deputy Clerk in the absence of the Clerk from time to time; and

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That Rachel Munro is appointed as an Acting Deputy Clerk for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie, on a temporary basis, to act in the absence of the Clerk from time to time until on or about November 1, 2022.
- 2. That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.
