INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

To Wayne Redekop for submission to the clerk with whom the nomination was filed, in accordance with Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

Qualified Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Financial Statement - Auditors' Report Candidate - Form 4 (the "Financial Statement") of the Wayne Redekop Election Campaign, for the period May 2, 2022 to December 31, 2022, prepared in accordance with Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the Financial Statement - Auditors' Report Part 4 of the Wayne Redekop 2022 Municipal Election Campaign for the period May 2, 2022 to December 31, 2022, is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 and in the prescribed form issued by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of municipal election campaigns, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of revenue and expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in the Candidate's election campaign accounting records and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions and other revenue and expenses.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement section of our report. We are independent of the Candidate in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statement in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Responsibilities of the Candidate for the Financial Statement

The Candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statement in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed in the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statement is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditors' report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit

conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this financial statement.

As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:
