



Engineering Intern Summer 2022

The Town of Fort Erie is now accepting applications for a Summer Intern in the Engineering Division for 2022.

The Engineering Intern will be a team oriented person with strong problem solving and analytical skills who is familiar with software used in an engineering environment. They will assist Town staff with sidewalk maintenance inspections, surveying and the traffic counting program. Additionally, they will support Project Managers by participating in field assessments, completing cost estimates and performing inspections related to capital projects.

Working in a safety focused environment with exacting Health and Safety standards the Engineering Intern will have an opportunity to learn and understand the issues and solutions related to Municipal Engineering.

Currently enrolled in a post-secondary institution studying Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering or other complimentary field, the ideal candidate is expected to be available for the entire summer season (16 weeks May-August). The hourly rate of pay will be based on experience.
