
Notice of Public Information Centre

Dovercourt Road Watermain

The Town of Fort Erie has initiated engineering design for the Dovercourt Road Watermain Replacement project. The proposed works include replacement of the existing watermain, improvement to the storm drainage system and road resurfacing from Graeber Avenue to Roxborough Avenue.



Public consultation on the proposed design and getting feedback is an important component of the project.
