

## HOW TO ADJUST YOUR BROWSER FONT SIZE

### Internet Explorer (IE)

Select View → Text Size → (Select the font size Largest, Larger, Medium, Smaller, Smallest.)

### Firefox

Select View → Text Size → (select Increase, Decrease, Normal)

#### **Shortcuts**

To make Text Bigger press & hold the CTRL and press +

To make Text Normal Size press & hold the CTRL and press 0 (zero)

To make Text Smaller press & hold the CTRL and press -

### Google Chrome

Select Page → Select Text zoom → (select Larger, Smaller, or Normal as necessary)

### Safari

Select View → Make Text Bigger (or Press & hold the CTRL and press +)

Select View → Make Text Normal Size (or Press & hold the CTRL and press 0 (zero))

Select View → Make Text Smaller (or Press & hold the CTRL and press -)

#### **Shortcuts**

To make Text Bigger press & hold the CTRL and press +

To make Text Normal Size press & hold the CTRL and press 0 (zero)

To make Text Smaller press & hold the CTRL and press -

### Netscape

Select View → Text Zoom → (select Smaller, Larger)

Select View → Text Zoom (90%) - indicates text size is selected to be 90% - 100% is considered Original font size.

Select View → Text Zoom → (select a percentage you want text displayed)

#### **Short Cuts**

To make Text Smaller press & hold the CTRL and press -

To make Text Larger press & hold the CTRL and press +

To return Text to Original Size press & hold the CTRL and press 0 (zero)
