

Notice of Public Information Centre

BATTERY STREET, DUFFERIN STREET AND MURRAY STREET SANITARY SEWERS

The Town of Fort Erie has initiated engineering design for the existing sanitary sewers and lateral replacement on Battery Street (Murray Street to Catherine Street), Dufferin Street (Central Avenue to Niagara Parkway) and Murray Street (Aberdeen Street to North Street and Stanton Street to Waterloo Street). In addition, watermain and services will be replaced as well as full road reconstruction will be completed on Murray Street (Aberdeen Street to Central Avenue) and Battery Street (Lavinia Street to Catherine Street). Construction work is tentatively scheduled to commence in the spring of 2018.



Public consultation on the proposed designs and getting feedback is an important component of the projects. As part of the public consultation for these projects, a formal Public Information Centre (PIC) is being planned to provide interested parties with an opportunity to review the designs and construction plans. These are pre-approved Schedule A+ Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) projects. Those attending the PIC will have an opportunity to meet with the Project Team and discuss issues related to the projects. The PIC will take place on:
