

COVID-19 Vaccine Requirements to Access the Fort Erie Arenas

All arena patrons are required to complete the COVID-19 screening and provide contact tracing information as they enter the facility. Face covering and physical distancing is also required by all patrons. Maximum capacities have been posted in each space of the arena. Rules will be monitored.

Commencing on September 22, 2021 proof of COVID-19 vaccination is required to enter any indoor recreation facility as outlined in Ontario Regulation 364/20. The following highlights the requirements to enter the Town of Fort Erie arenas.

Proof of vaccination is required for all patrons (participants and spectators) 12 years of age and over.

- Patrons must provide proof of the full series of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized by Health Canada.
- A copy of your vaccination receipt will be required along with proof of identification to enter the facility.
- A copy of the vaccination receipt can be obtained from the COVID-19 vaccination provincial portal at [covid-19.ontario.ca](https://www.covid-19.ontario.ca)
- Proof of identification must include the full name of the identification holder **and** Date of birth (ie; drivers license, health card, birth certificate).

Exemptions

1. Patrons under 18 years of age who are entering solely for the purpose of actively participating in an organized sport. Once participation in sport is complete, unvaccinated must vacate the facility once they leave the dressing room.
 - a. Except where required by a youth organization.
2. A person who provides a documented reason for not being fully vaccinated, the written document must be completed and supplied by a physician or registered nurse in accordance with the Ministry of Health guidance.
